Update on Northgate Development

- Derelict building on Hunter St: part of compulsory purchase, was used for material storage during construction of Storyhouse, has been made more secure, usage tbd
- Parking: current plan (not finalised): 700 spaces over 7 floors
- Traffic flow: tbd but aim will be on minimal impact
- Phase 2: consultation in March, planning application in May
