 - 9. Music good background music that people enjoyed
 - 10. Timing consider time of the day and also if to hold early or later in the summer when warmer

 - 12. Raffle good idea, share profits between committee and a charity, let people know beforehand
 - 13. Review overall party costs have a model that works, identify overall KSARA costs per year
